

The first 'Molecule of the Week' (MotW) is a gold(I) catenane published in the current issue of *Angewandte Chemie International Edition* (Goldup, S.M.; Leigh, D.A.; Lusby, P.J.; McBurney, R.T.; Slawin, A.M.Z. *Angew. Chem. Int. Ed.* **2008**, *47*, 6999-7003). Catenanes consist of two or more interlocking macrocycles, think of a magician's 'linking rings.' I chose this molecule simply because I think it's wickedly cool, and that's enough for me, although they, along with rotaxanes, have potential as molecular machines (http://en.wikipedia.org/wiki/Molecular\_machine).
